"Sumisu Jo Gakko"

Girls' Boarding School of the Presbyterian Mission, Sapporo

This name, Sumisu Jo Gakko, was given to the school by the trustees two years and a half after it was founded, [a]s it had not been recognized by the Government as a school and private individuals had attached the founders name to it to distinguish it from "Sapporo Jo Gakko," which the Government had established; and it was was deemed unwise, at that time, to give any other; yet it must have a name in order to obtain a lease of government buildings for it.

This school was opened January 1887. Miss Tei Asawo and a sewing teacher were the assistants. The first students were: Miss Sono Soma, Miss Kawasaki, Miss Takayama, Miss Yoshimoto, Miss Kawai, Miss Chika Iwaya and Miss Ito Iwaya, all from Hakodate. These were soon joined by day students until the number was too large to be accommodated in the small rooms provided for them; which rooms were formerly a part of a stable which had been made over and fitted up for the accomodation of servants. One room was six feet by nine and the other nine by twelve. [G]overnor Iwamura learning of our need for more room kindly had built for us a small two story house with a room below twenty-one feet by thirty-three, and a sewing-room and a sleeping-room above.

Half of the salary received from the Normal School was allowed for the purchase of an organ (second hand) and for other expenses of the school during two and a half years, after which the entire expense has been paid by our Board.
